Round trip cruise with Dubrovnik

FROM TROGIR TO BOL, HVAR ISLAND, NP MLJET, DUBROVNIK, KORČULA, PUČIŠĆA, SPLIT TO TROGIR



Day 1 TROGIR ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split airport to the Trogir port. Embarkation starts at 2:00 PM. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome Reception followed by dinner.

Day 2 TROGIR – BOL – HVAR ISLAND, Sunday (B, L)

In the morning, we are sailing towards the island of Hvar, we are cruising along Bol on Brač Island, the most beautiful beach in the entire Mediterranean – “Zlatni Rat” (the Golden Horn), which is constantly changing its shape due to the ocean currents. Along the way to Island of Hvar we take a short break swimming, cooling off and relaxing, if the weather permits. Lunch on board and set sail for Hvar on the island of Hvar, a charming seaside town with 8 centuries of architecture, and a favorite holiday destination for international celebrities. During a walking tour, visit many historical sites, such as St Stephen’s Square and Cathedral, the Arsenal with the theatre built on its first floor, the first municipal theatre in Europe. Above the town is the impressive fortress Fortica offering magnificent views over the bay and Pakleni islands. Your evening is free in Hvar. You can explore more and dine on your own in one of the many restaurants in town.

Note: Due to the limited capacity of the Hvar harbor (during peak season) port of call can be substituted for Stari Grad. In that case transfer by bus will be organized to and from Hvar.

Day 3 HVAR ISLAND – MLJET National Park, Monday (B, L)

In the morning head further south to the Island of Mljet. Mljet National Park encompasses five types of forest, many species of birds and two deep lakes, Veliko Jezero (Big Lake) and Malo Jezero (Small Lake) and join the boat ride to St. Mary Island. Join the Cruise Manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park. Alternatively, you can rent bicycles, scooters, or kayaks to explore the National Park or island on your own. Spend the night in Mljet.

Day 4 MLJET National Park – DUBROVNIK, Tuesday (B, L)

In the morning sail to Dubrovnik, the “Pearl of the Adriatic”, a famous UNESCO World Heritage site. Upon arrival in Dubrovnik, your guided tour will immerse you in its history and points of interest as you walk Stradun, the landmark street & square. Enjoy free time after your city tour to marvel at the City Walls, the Franciscan Monastery (home to Europe’s second oldest pharmacy), the Rector’s Palace, and the Cathedral. Alternatively, take a scenic boat excursion to Lokrum island or ride the cable car to the top of the Mount Srđ. Overnight in Dubrovnik.

Day 5 DUBROVNIK – KORČULA (Wine tasting), Wednesday (B, L, T)

Early in the morning we set sail for the island

of Korčula, with swim stop, weather permitting, in one of pristine bays, time to relax and lunch on board. Continue towards Pučišća, the most preserved medieval town, and birthplace of the famous explorer Marco Polo. Take a walking tour of Korčula which takes you through its narrow, cobbled streets full of history and enjoy wine tasting in one of the local wine bars. Evening is free to explore the town on your own.

Day 6 KORČULA – PUČIŠĆA, Thursday (B, L, CD)

Our journey continues towards Pučišća. Lunch on board and enjoy a swim in one of Brač’ many lovely coves and bays, if weather permits. Town Pučišća is situated on the island of Brač, village of the stone sculpture, where you can visit amazing stonemason school (optional). Enjoy Captain’s dinner on board and overnight in Pučišća.

Day 7 PUČIŠĆA – SPLIT – TROGIR, Friday (B, L)

In the morning, we set sail to Split with a stop along the way to swim, cool off and relax, if weather permits, and lunch on board. Upon arrival in Split, you will enjoy a walking tour of the historic inner city that takes us to the Palace of the Roman Emperor Diocletian, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. We see the remnants of Split’s Roman heritage, its Renaissance and Gothic structures, Jupiter’s Temple, the Peristyle, and the Cathedral. After visiting Split set sail to the UNESCO-listed city of Trogir sometimes referred to as “miniature Venice” or a “mini-Dubrovnik” because of its ancient walls, or a floating

museum town - as it has a masterful architecture including some stunning Venetian palaces Your time here is free to explore on your own. Overnight in Trogir.

Note: Due to limited capacity of the Split harbor (ongoing reconstruction) we will sail directly to the port of Trogir. In that case transfer by bus will be organized to and from Split town.

Day 8 TROGIR DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

After breakfast it is time to disembark no later than 9:00h. You will be transferred to Split airport.

FROM TROGIR TO ŠIBENIK, NP KRKA, GALEŠNJAK, ZADAR, SALI, NP TELAŠČICA, NP KORNATI, PRIMOŠTEN, HVAR ISLAND, STARI GRAD, SPLIT AND TROGIR



Day 1 TROGIR ARRIVAL, Saturday (WR, D)

You will be transferred from Split airport to the Trogir port. Embarkation starts at 2 pm. Get settled in your cabin before attending a Welcome reception followed by dinner this evening.

Day 2 TROGIR – ŠIBENIK (Krka National Park excursion), Sunday (B, L, T)

Depart from Trogir early in the morning towards Šibenik. After arrival to Šibenik, continue by bus to visit Krka National Park. Krka's magnificent waterfalls, including the famous waterfall Skradinski Buk, are one of Croatia's most famous sights. We return to Šibenik, a city of exceptional history and rich cultural heritage. Set out on a walking tour of Šibenik historical center and visit one of the most beautiful Renaissance Cathedrals of the Adriatic. Your evening is at leisure in town.

Day 3 ŠIBENIK – GALEŠNJAK – ZADAR (Wine tasting), Monday (B, L, T)

Early in the morning, we leave Šibenik and set sail for Galešnjak, a typical small Dalmatian Island, where you will enjoy a swim stop in one of secluded bays. Enjoy lunch while we sail into Zadar port. After arrival, join for a walking tour of Zadar's historical center and its' old walls and Port Gate built in the 16th century. Visit the Square of the Five Wells, see the Church of St. Donat, the Roman Forum and the largest Cathedral in Dalmatia, St. Anastasia and enjoy wine tasting in one of the local wine bars. If there is a breeze, enjoy the "Sea Organ",

an architectural sound art, which plays music by way of sea waves move into the tubes. Overnight in Zadar.

Day 4 ZADAR – SALI – TELAŠČICA Nature Park, Tuesday (B, L, CD)

Morning departure for Sali, a tourist and fishing town on the island Dugi Otok (Long Island) and the nearest town to the "Telašćica" Nature Park and National Park "Kornati". It is mentioned in the 12th century, having received its name from its salt works, and today it is a favorite destination for divers. We set sail for the Telašćica Nature Park, followed by the visit to the Nature Park, which, due to its distinct beauty, wealth and importance, along with 6 islets within the bay of Telašćica itself, was declared a nature park in 1988. Free time to explore the white cliffs and lakes. In the evening enjoy Captain's dinner on board and overnight in Telašćica Nature Park.

Day 5 TELAŠČICA – KORNATI National Park – PRIMOŠTEN, Wednesday (B, L)

In the morning, we will continue towards National Park Kornati, comprised of 89 unforgettable islands, islets and reefs. Kornati National Park is often mentioned as a "nautical paradise" and a rich marine eco-system. Afterwards we continue to Primošten. Primošten is a small, picturesque town situated between Šibenik and Trogir in the central part of the Adriatic coast and surrounded by seven islets, a wonderful sight and an

exceptional breathtaking place to explore built on a hill and dominated by the parish Church of St. George which was built in 1485. Your evening is at leisure in town. Overnight in Primošten.

Day 6 PRIMOŠTEN – STARI GRAD (Hvar sightseeing), Thursday (B, L)

Leaving Primošten in the morning and sailing towards Stari Grad on the Island of Hvar. Stari Grad is one of the oldest towns in Europe with many friendly and affordable conobas and restaurants in the backstreets of the old town. The Stari Grad Plain and the old town center of Stari Grad have been listed as UNESCO World Heritage Sites since 2008. After disembarking in Stari Grad we will take the bus to visit the town of Hvar, followed by a tour of the town - which will show you many historical sites, such as St Stephen's Square and Cathedral, the Arsenal with the theatre built on its first floor, the first municipal theatre in Europe. Above the town is the impressive fortress Fortica offering magnificent views over the bay and Pakleni islands. In the evening, arrival by bus to Stari Grad. Overnight onboard in Stari Grad.



Day 7 STARI GRAD – SPLIT – TROGIR, Friday (B, L)

We will have an early morning sailing towards Split. After docking join a guided tour of Split, visit the seafront promenade and Roman Emperor Diocletian's Palace. The historical center of the city is listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Walk through the basement of the palace filled with market stalls and experience the historic architecture of this beautiful palace. See the remains of Split's Roman heritage, as well as its Renaissance and Gothic structures, the Temple of Jupiter, the Peristyle and many other unique places. After visiting Split set sail to the UNESCO-listed city of Trogir sometimes referred to as "miniature Venice" or a "mini-Dubrovnik" because of its ancient walls, also known as a floating museum town. Overnight onboard in Trogir.

Note: Due to the limited capacity of the Split harbor (due to reconstruction) we will sail directly to the port of Trogir. In that case transfer by bus will be organized to and from Split town.

Day 8 TROGIR DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

Disembark after breakfast, no later than 9:00am. You will be transferred to Split airport.

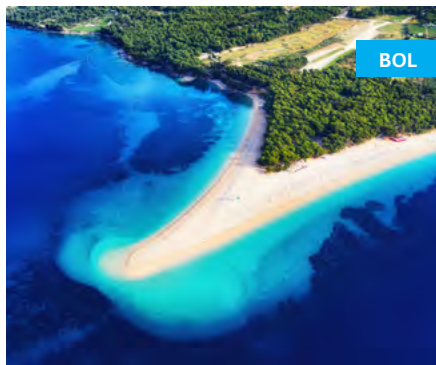
Day 5 KORČULA – MLJET National Park – LASTOVO Nature Park, Wednesday (B, L, CD)

In the morning head further south to the Island of Mljet. Join the Cruise Manager for a stroll to the famous salt lakes in the Mljet National Park. Alternatively, you can rent bicycles, scooters, or

kayaks to explore the National Park or island on your own. Continue sailing through lunch, arriving this afternoon in Lastovo, an island known for its Venetian architecture from the 15th and 16th centuries. The island of Lastovo and the Lastovo archipelago, which includes 46 islands, islets, rocks, and reefs, are a nature park in Croatia where the sea is crystal clear, and the sky is full of stars that shine like the most beautiful evening gown. We dock in the port of Ubli where you can enjoy your free time and explore the beauty of the island. From there, a local taxi can take you to the town of Lastovo, where you can visit a local winery and taste some of the indigenous varieties of wine. Enjoy Captain's dinner on board and overnight in Lastovo.

Day 6 LASTOVO Nature Park – BIŠEVO – VIS ISLAND, Thursday (B, L)

Early in the morning we sail to the small island Biševo to visit (weather permitted) the Blue Cave, a magnificent natural phenomenon* before arriving in today's ultimate destination of Vis. Once a strategic naval Yugoslav base, some of Europe's largest and greatest naval battles occurred here. Previously restricted to the public, Vis provides a unique opportunity to see "the Mediterranean as it once was" The day is yours to explore Vis independently and we recommend going on one of the military history tours. Overnight in one of the harbors of Vis.



Day 7 VIS ISLAND – TROGIR, Friday (B, L)

Early morning departure to the old Dalmatian town Trogir. After docking join a guided tour of Trogir. Trogir is sometimes referred to as “miniature Venice” or a “mini-Dubrovnik” because of its ancient walls, or a “floating museum town”. Afterwards, you will discover the beauty of the Krka National Park and the small access port of Skradin where the flora and fauna are exceptional. Overnight in Trogir.

Day 8 TROGIR DEPARTURE, Saturday (B)

After breakfast it is time to disembark, no later than 9:00am. You will be transferred to the Split airport.

B-Breakfast, L-Lunch, D-Dinner, WR-Welcome Reception, CD-Captain's dinner, T-Tasting

Which cabins are better?

Just so you know, cabins below deck are much quieter, provide more privacy and peace, allowing you to fall asleep listening to the quiet sound of waves, and to wake up with a smile. Like trying to retell a dream, choose one of our cabins on deck, and be prepared to experience amazing beauty in every moment of your cruise. Just open the door and witness magical sunrise and sunset. Every cabin has its special story...

Beverages

Water dispenser available throughout the cruise. A bar is available on all ships serving a selection of beers, wine, spirits and soft drinks. All drinks purchased on board are payable in cash at the end of your cruise. We do not allow any drinks or food bought on-shore to be brought on board the ships. We suggest you not to drink tap water.

Is there a doctor aboard?

There is no doctor aboard, but the crew is qualified for giving first aid. However, in every port there are specialized medical teams or health facilities.

Is a cruise suitable for children?

Of course it is. And without any doubt, it is a great experience for children. Because of the special conditions aboard, we recommend our cruises for children at least at school age, and they should be able to swim.

How much luggage can I take aboard?

Generally, there is no limit, but you should keep in mind that the space in the cabins is restricted. If you hate packing, no worries, you only need to bring a bathing suit and couple of shorts and T-shirts on our cruise - don't overpack.

Do motorized sailing boats sail during the night?

No, our motorized sailing boats sail exclusively during daylight. During the night, they will moor in harbours or coves.

Is sleeping on deck permitted?

It certainly is. For many of our guests, it is a unique experience to spend the night in the fresh air, under the Mediterranean stars.

Is there enough shade aboard?

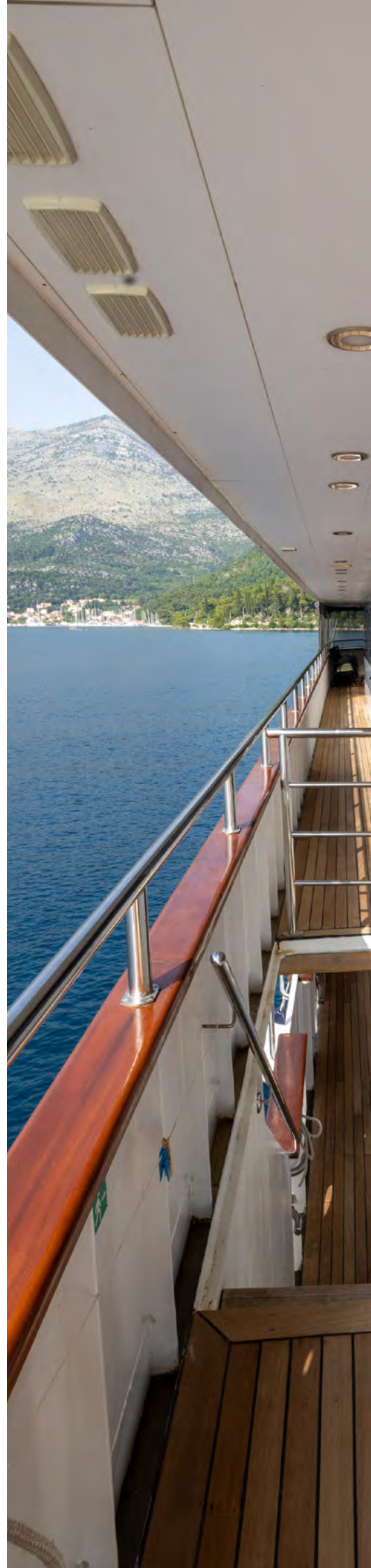
Of course, there is enough shade aboard. Usually, bigger vessels have got a canopied part at the stern on the main deck, in addition to that, parts of the sundeck are protected by a canvas cover.

Can I pay with credit card on the ship?

Credit cards on board are accepted on most of our supreme ships. Credit cards are not accepted on our superior ship, however, your Cruise manager will gladly direct you to ATM machines.

Are cruise ships wheelchair accessible?

Due to the specific mooring conditions and requirements in some Croatian ports, ships are moored side by side, making it necessary to cross from one ship to another with gaps in between, to get to the shore. In such cases guests need to take special care when crossing and do this at their own risk. Crew assistance will be given to those needing and requesting it but cruises are not recommended for clients in wheelchairs or with limited mobility.





Are towels provided on board?

For your comfort, bath towels and a beach towel are provided on all our ships. There is the possibility of renting towels for the beach with a maximum cost of 7 euro per pcs/week.

What electricity is on board?

In our Ships we have available electricity 220 V. Due to security measures it is not allowed to have plugs in the bathrooms of the cabins.

Is smoking allowed on board?

Smoking in the restaurant area and in the cabins is not allowed. There will be a small-designated area outside for smokers away from the general entertaining areas. Passengers must not throw cigarette butts in the sea.

Are there baby cribs available in the ships?

Baby crib is available on request only, with supplement. In case any guest wants to bring their own baby crib, please inform us at the time of booking to try to assign a cabin with enough space for it.

What if I have dietary requirements?

The cuisine on board is a combination of Mediterranean and international cuisine, with traditional Croatian dishes, and includes seafood typical of the region. If you have any dietary requirements, we kindly ask you to provide information in advance to enable the chef to accommodate these dietary needs upon arrival.

Is there a laundry service on board?

No.
