Day by Day Itinerary

- Day 1: Sunday** - You will be met and **transferred to your hotel**. There's time to relax before tonight's welcome reception with your tour director and fellow travelers.
- Day 2: Monday** - During this guided city tour, we see the landmarks of Germany's capital. We end our sightseeing with a **one-hour Cruise** on the River Spree. The afternoon and evening is **free to enjoy your own activities**. Optional tour: Visit of Pergamon Museum. **(B)**
- Day 3: Tuesday** - The former royal city of **Potsdam**, a UNESCO World Heritage Site, with its extraordinary collection of palaces and parks, lies just a stone's throw from the center of Berlin. Our excursion of **Sanssouci Palace** includes a stroll through the magnificent gardens, the Dutch quarter and the Russian colony. Afterward, we **return to Berlin** where the remainder of the day is at leisure. Optional tour: Berlin beer tour. **(B)**
- Day 4: Wednesday** - After breakfast, we **drive to Dresden**, the capital of the Free State of Saxony. After our visit, we **continue to Nürnberg**, where, between 1945 and 1946, a series of World War II military tribunals were held. The evening is free. **(B)**
- Day 5: Thursday** - We continue our journey to **Regensburg**, "Germany's best-preserved medieval city" and a regional trading center since the 9th century. After a short visit, we travel to the **Dachau Concentration Camp** Memorial Site. Later in the afternoon, we arrive in Munich where the rest of the day is at leisure. **(B)**
- Day 6: Friday** - A morning guided tour of the Bavarian capital includes Nymphenburg Castle and the Olympic Grounds. After the tour, we visit the famous Hofbrauhaus and enjoy a traditional lunch. The **afternoon is free**. Optional tour: Munich Food Tour **(B, L)**
- Day 7: Saturday** - We explore more of the Freestate of **Bavaria** with a visit to Neuschwanstein Castle. After our visit to **Neuschwanstein**, we continue to the Village of Oberammergau. Here, we visit Pilatushaus and observe a wood-carver at work. Later, we return to Munich. In the evening join your fellow travelers and your travel director for our **farewell dinner**. **(B,D)**
- Day 8: Sunday** - After breakfast, you will be transferred to the airport for your **departure flight**. Alternatively, you can continue your journey and join Kompas' "Capitals of the Habsburg Empire" tour. **(B)**
