Day 1: Arrival in Vilnius, the capital of Lithuania. Optional transfer to your hotel. Check-in at the hotel. Welcome drink with the tour guides at Radisson BLU Royal Astorija lobby bar.

es, a famous hill with more than a thousand crosses, and the splendid 18th century
Rundale Palace, the former summer residence of the Duke of Kurland. Lunch on the
Kurland. Lunch on the way to Riga. **Arrival in Riga**, check-in at the hotel. **(B,L)** 

After breakfast, Riga city tour. The old town will delight you with the colourfully restored merchant's residences, the cosy beer cellars and cafes, historical monuments like the Dome Cathedral (Picture 5), St Peter's Church, the Powder Tower and more.

View the masterpieces of early 20th century.. Afternoon at leisure. (B)

Start with an optional 5 hour Sigulda sightseeing tour. Sigulda is often called the "Lat vian Switzerland" because of the beauty of its landscape. Visit the 13th century Turaida castle and the mysterious Gutmana Cave. Afternoon at leisure. (B)

Day 6: After breakfast, departure by coach to Tallinn. En route, sightseeing at the Ethnograph ic Open Air Museum on the outskirts of Riga to see the traditional Latvian rural buildings, the oldest ones dating from the 17th century. View the Baltic Sea coast along the way and enjoy a sightseeing tour of the Estonian town Parnu. Lunch on the way. Arrival in Tallinn, check in at the hotel. (B,L)

Day 7: After breakfast, in the medieval town. In the afternoon, enjoy an optional 3 hour tour to Kadriorg Park & Palace. (B)

- Day 1: Friday Vilnius: Arrive in and transfer to your downtown hotel. Depending on your arrival time, join the tours inside the Synagogue. Friday night dinner and overnight in Vilnius. (D)
- Day 2: Saturday Vilnius: This morning, visit the synagogue service. In the afternoon, take part in the **Old Vilnius City tour.** You'll learn about the Great Vilna Synagogue and the Ghettos, where more than 40,000 Jews were kept between 1941-1943. Overnight in Vilnius. **(B)**
- Day 3: Sunday Ponar, Trakai, Vilnius: Morning departure to Trakai, the ancient capital of the Grand Duchy of Lithuania. Stovilnius and visit the grave at the Ponar Forest and Memorial, where thousands of Jews were shot in the early days of the war, but never forgotten. Learn about the escape tunnel which was discovered just Recently. Continue to Trakai, famous for the medieval insular castle and heritage of Karaites ethnic minority. Return to Vilnius and visit the grave of Vilna Gaun. Overnight in Vilnius. (B)
- Day 4: Monday Ziezmariai, Kaunas: After breakfast, depart for Kaunas. Stop at the unique wooden synagogue of Ziezmarial. During your sightseeing tour in Kaunas second largest city of Lithuania you will see all the major sights. You'll learn about Leah Goldberg's life and how the Japanese diplomat Chiune Sugihara saved about 6,000 Jewish people when the Holocaust started. Overnight in Kaunas. (B)
- Day 5: Tuesday Kedainiai, Rundale, Riga: After breakfast, visit the Ninth Fort Museum and departs for Riga, the capital of Latvia. En route stop in Kedainiai citadel of the Radzivil family, one of the most powerful in the late Middle Ages. Afternoon arrival in Riga. (B)
- Day 6: Wednesday Riga: City tour of Riga after breakfast. Visit the remaining synagogue, the central meeting place for Jews in Latvia. Overnight in Riga. (B)
- Day 7: Thursday Parnu, Tallinn: After breakfast, drive alongside the Riga Bay to Estonia's capital, Tallinn. Pass by part of the Gauja National Park and stop at medieval Turaida Castle. Later, visit Parnu, Estonia's famous resort town. Late afternoon arrival in Tallinn. (B)
- Day 8: Friday Tallinn: After breakfast, tour the charming city of Tallinn. Drive to Old Town, on top of the hill, to see the breathtaking views of the tiled roofs and colorful buildings be low. Continue to the intimate Tallinn Jewish Center to learn about Jewish community life in Estonia. Visit the synagogue. The afternoon is at your leisure. Overnight in Tallinn. (B)
