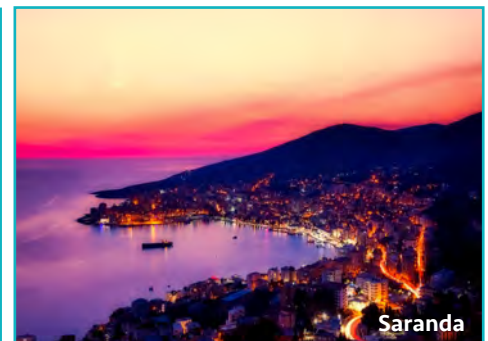
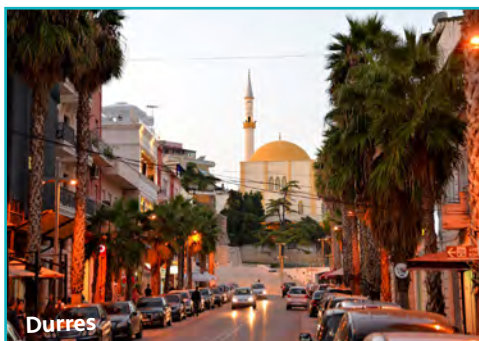

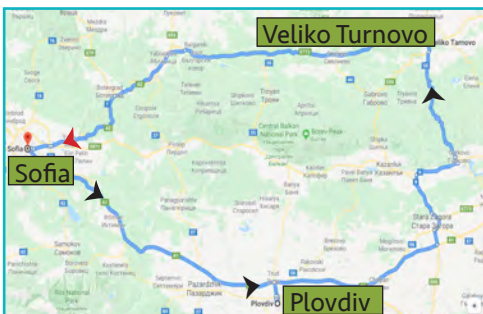

Day 3.

Walk in the unique and unrivalled Hall of Mirrors (357 mirrors in all); followed by the Royal Chapel, as well as the King and Queen's Royal Apartments. You will be stunned by the Gardens (Europe's largest royal gardens) and the beauty of the Fountains (Apollo, Latona, Neptune,...) all created by France's world famous landscape gardener, André Le Nôtre. - Day 1:** **Pick up in Budapest at 9am.** Drive to Gödöllő., a favorite summer retreat of the Hapsburgs. Visit the Baroque Grassalkovich Palace. Drive through the picturesque Mátra Mountains, site of Hungary's highest peak (Kékes, 3,039 ft.). **Afternoon arrival in Eger,** famed for its wine and legendary resistance to the invading Turks and Hapsburgs. Walking tour of historic Eger. Dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Eger. **(D)**
- Day 2:** After breakfast, depart for Mezőkövesd, marketplace of the "Matyó" folk artists, famous for richly decorated embroidery work. **Continue to Kecskemét.** Walking tour of the city. You'll see all the major sights. Hungarian dinner with wine and gypsy music in a Csárda in nearby Lajosmizse. Return to overnight in Kecskemét. **(B,D)**
- Day 3:** After breakfast, **depart for Kalocsa,** land of "red gold", better known as paprika. 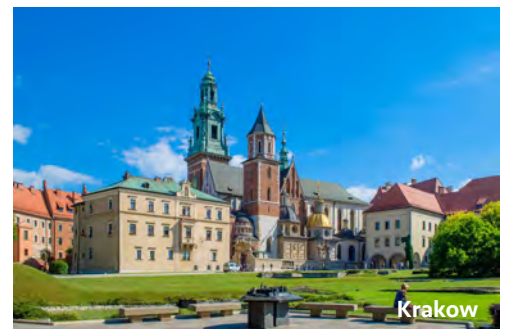
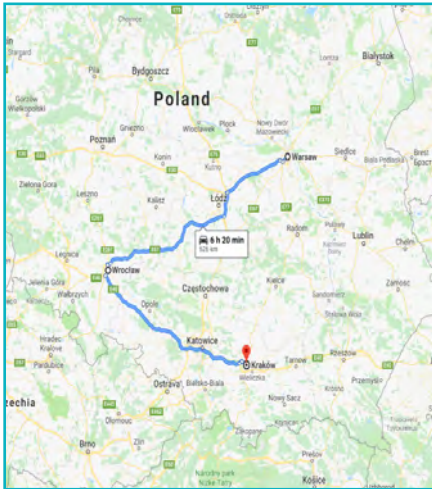

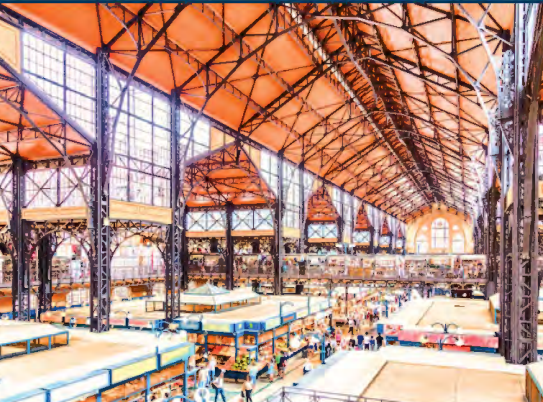
