

Day 1.

Arrive in Budapest, Hungary. At the airport, an English speaking guide will meet you along with a chauffeur driven car to transfer you to your deluxe hotel. The balance of the day is at leisure. Overnight in Budapest, deluxe hotel of your choice. (B)

Day 2.

After breakfast, private guided sightseeing tour of Budapest, including the Royal Castle, Matthias Church, Fisherman's Bastion, the Parliament, St. Stephen's Basilica and Hero's Square. Day. 4

We suggest, that for tonight, plan a fun dinner in Grinzing - the famous wine growing village on the outskirts of Vienna. In Grinzing's "Heurigen" restaurants, dinner is always accompanied by "Schrammel" music, played by a quartet of instruments: violins, an accordion and a guitar. Overnight in Vienna at a deluxe hotel of your choice. **(B)**

Day 5.

Buffet breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, private guided city tour of Vienna, including the Ringstrasse, the Vienna State Opera House, Hofburg Palace & Museum of Fine Arts. You will also visit the Imperial Rooms of the Schönbrunn Palace. Upon request, Jewish Heritage tour instead of the city tour. In the evening, cultural program: Mozart Concert or a performance of the Vienna Boys' Choir. Opera is also available - for an additional charge - except in July and August. Overnight in Vienna. (B)

Today is at leisure. Perhaps you can visit the countryside - the romantic Danube Valley - with a visit of the **Abbey of Melk** and a walking tour of medieval Dürnstein. Or you may want to do some shopping in the trendy boutiques in downtown Vienna. Overnight in Vienna. **(B)**

Skopje was an important city for the Ottomans from the end of the 14th century. The Skopje of today retains that influence and is a thriving modern city. The largest Turkish bath in the Balkans is located here and is now an Art Museum. We will visit the Turkish Bazaar and the National Museum. Overnight in Skopje. (B)

Day 7.

After breakfast, **drive to Prizren in Kosovo**, a true open air museum and one of the most beautiful towns in Kosovo, situated on the slopes of the Sharr Mountains and on the banks of the river Bistrica. The craftsmen of Prizren are well known for their beautiful gold and silver items. Optional dinner and overnight in Prizren. **(B)**

Day 8.

After breakfast, tour the old part of Prizren. Then cross the border to Albania to visit Shkodra. It has been an important city for over 2,000 years. Once part of the Venetian Empire, Italian influence is evident everywhere. Visit Rozafa Castle. Optional dinner and overnight in Shkodra. (B)


