DAILY Itinerary

DAY 1	ARRIVE IN EDINBURGH, SCOTLAND Private Transfer Airport to City Centre Edinburgh. Your accommodation is at the 3 star Hotel Brooks Edinburgh for 2 nights, including Full Scottish breakfast.
DAY 2	DAY IN EDINBURGH Breakfast at the hotel. Day at leisure. Overnight at your hotel.
DAY 3	VISIT TO ST. ANDREWS AND INVERNESS 9:00AM pick up for a full day tour to St. Andrews and Inverness. At Andrew's Links Trust, a guided walk of the Old Course, St. Andrews Castle and St. Andrews Cathedral. Continue to Inverness. Accommodation at Kingsmills Hotel, Inverness with a full Scottish breakfast.
DAY 4	TRAIN TO GLASGOW Walk from hotel to the train station for the high speed rail for a direct ride to Glasgow in the early afternoon. Accommodation at the Carlton George Hotel, Glasgow, including a full Scottish breakfast.
DAY 5	DAY IN GLASGOW Day at your leisure. Breakfast at your hotel.
DAY 6	FLY TO BELFAST, IRELAND Your private driver will collect you from Belfast airport and transfer you to the city centre for your 3 nights stay in Belfast. Enjoy your first evening at leisure.
DAY 7	DAY IN BELFAST Day at your leisure to explore the city.
DAY 8	VISIT DERRY CITY Leave Belfast for the day, and head to Derry City with your private driver. Full Day on your own. Return private transfer in the early evening.
DAY 9	TRAIN TO DUBLIN Your local private driver will collect you from your hotel toady and transfer you to Belfast Train Station with direct train service from Belfast City to Dublin. Overnight accommodation at the 3 star Academy Plaza Hotel in Dublin including full Irish breakfast for 2 nights.
DAY 10	DAY IN DUBLIN Explore Dublin on your own. Dublin is the largest city in Ireland and was established in 988AD by Viking settlers.
DAY 9	DEPART DUBLIN Make your own arrangement for transfer to Dublin Airport for your departure flight. Bid farewell to Ireland.
