### Day by Day Itinerary

- Day 1:** At 6:00pm, **meet your guide and the rest of the group** in the hotel lobby. Drive along the beautifully renovated Royal Route. Stop at Castle Square for a short walk through Old Town and then join us for welcome dinner. **(D)**
- Day 2:** This morning, take a half-day sightseeing tour includes Old Town. After lunch, we continue our tour with a drive to the area of the former Warsaw Ghetto. Later, take a musical journey with our greatest composer, **Frederic Chopin**, in a piano recital. **(B,L)**
- Day 3:** The road to Krakow, Poland's unique, medieval, open-air museum, leads us past Czestochowa. Lunch is served at a local restaurant. En route to Krakow, we stop at **Auschwitz**, site of the concentration camp. **(B,L)**
- Day 4:** The morning **sightseeing tour will feature all the major sights**. The afternoon is at leisure. Dinner will be served in Old Town. **(B,D)**
- Day 5:** After breakfast, we visit the Czartoryski Museum that presents the most valuable art collection in Poland. After lunch, **we drive to Zakopane**. **(B,L)**
- Day 6:** In the morning, you will have a sightseeing tour of Zakopane. You will visit the Jaszczurowka Chapel and the Sanctuary of Our Lady of Fatima at Krzeptowki. After lunch on your own, you will have free time. Tonight's dinner will be served at a typical Highlanders' inn with a folkloric show. **(B,D)**
- Day 7:** Today **we depart to the historic city of Wroclaw**. Known as "Venice of the North". En route, we stop in Wadowice, the birthplace of John Paul II. Later, drive to Wroclaw. **(B,L)**
- Day 8:** After breakfast, sightseeing of Wroclaw with visit Panorama Raclawicka. From here, we drive to **Poznan** and stay overnight in the Sheraton Hotel. Enjoy dinner in the hotel restaurant. **(B,D)**
- Day 9:** **Start the day with a city tour of Poznan**. The most interesting part of the city is Old Town. After lunch, we continue to Torun. **(B,L)**
- Day 10:** Take a tour of **Torun**, the birthplace of Copernicus. Its Old Town has been included in the UNESCO's list. Lunch will be served in Torun. Later, we drive to Gdansk. **(B,L)**
- Day 11:** Today, we tour **Gdansk** in depth. From here we drive to Gdynia. After lunch, we continue our drive to Sopot. The rest of the day is free. **(B,L)**
- Day 12:** After breakfast, we drive to Olsztyn. We stop at the Teutonic Knights Castle in Malbork. Lunch will be served at a local restaurant. We continue to Olsztyn, a town located in a region of lakes and forests. Enjoy a picnic with folkloric music in Gietrzwałd. **(B,L,D)**
- Day 13:** After breakfast, **we return to Warsaw**. You will be invited for a home-hosted dinner by a local family, whose charming cottage is located at the foot of the former Lowicz Castle. After dinner, we continue your drive to Warsaw. **(B,D)**
- Day 14:** Breakfast at the hotel. This is the end of your tour. **(B)**
