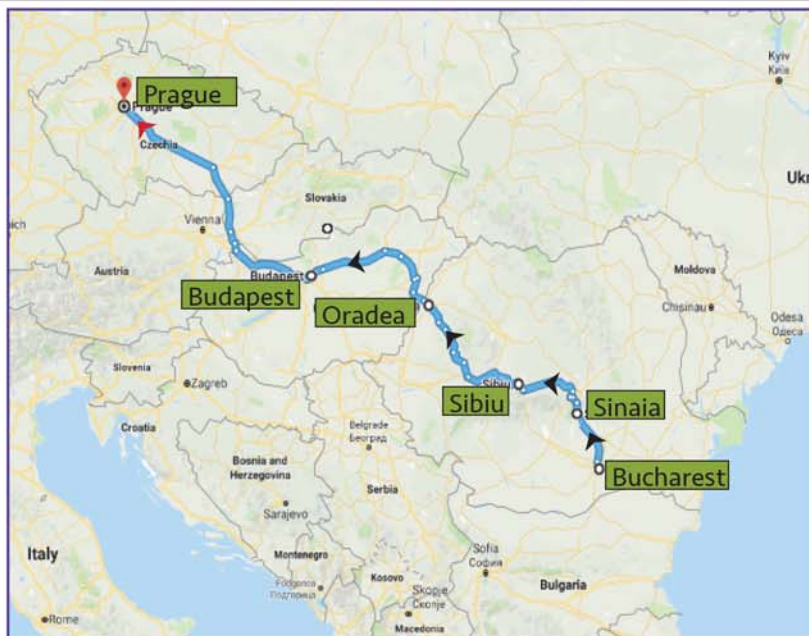

DAY BY DAY ITINERARY

Day 1: Arrive in Bucharest, the capital of Romania. Private transfer to the hotel. Overnight in Bucharest.

Day 2: Buffet breakfast at your hotel. Your private half day city tour includes the major sights of the city, such as like The Parliament Palace, also known as The People's House, the second largest building in the world, after Pentagon, The Revolution Square, The Opera Square, Victoria Ave and the Triumphal Arch.. Later, private transfer to Sinaia, the former summer residence of the Romanian royalties. Sightseeing in Sinaia. (B)

Day 3: After breakfast, proceed to Dracula's Bran Castle, then continue to Brasov. Walking tour features the Black Church and the Council's Square. Later, arrive in Sibiel - a village that received the Golden Apple Award in 2010. The greater part of the villages in this area preserved strong spiritual and ethno-folkloric traditions. Continue to Sibiu - one of the oldest towns in Transylvania - formerly Hermannstadt. Take a guided walking tour of the medieval town. Overnight in Sibiu. (B)

Day 4: Buffet breakfast at your hotel. Then, visit the neighboring villages and towns. Sighisoara with its medieval fortress and the birthplace of Vlad Dracula. On the way, stop in the town of Biertan. Visit Targu Mures - one of the most interesting cities in Romania. Return to Sibiu. (B)

Day 5: Buffet breakfast at your hotel. Drive to Alba Julia. Alba Iulia was the Residence of the Transylvanian princes and of the Catholic bishops. From 1599 to 1601, Alba Iulia was the capital of the united principalities of Walachia, Transylvania and Moldavia. Later, continue to Cluj Napoca. Drive to Oradea, walking tour of the city center and overnight here. (B)

Day 6: Drive to Debrecen and visit Hortobágy National Park, the largest continuous natural grassland in Europe. Hortobágy has outstanding landscape features and is a unique example of the harmonic coexistence of people and nature based on the considerate use of the land, maintaining great biological variety in respect of species and habitats. Stop in Kalocsa city for a sightseeing tour. Continue to Budapest and overnight there. (B)

Day 7: Buffet breakfast at your hotel. After, take a half day Grand City Tour of Budapest. The tour starts from the Chain Bridge, passes by the Parliament and takes the Margaret Bridge to drive over to the Buda side. You will stop in the Castle District and during a short walk you will see the main attractions of the area. Overnight in Budapest. (B)

Day 8: After breakfast, time at leisure. Later, take a half day scheduled tour to Szentendre. This charming village has a lot to offer. Return to Budapest for overnight. (B)

Day 9: Full day excursion to Lake Balaton via Herend, famous porcelain factory. We take you to Herend first, to the famous Porcelain Manufactory, founded 1826. Next, drive to Lake Balaton (the largest fresh-water lake of Central Europe) and visit the abbey (founded 1055) on the Tihany Peninsula. Following a 3-course lunch in a „csárda” restaurant, continue to Balatonfüred and walk along the famous promenade. Return to Budapest, the tour ends in the city center. (B)

Day 10: After breakfast, private transfer to the train station. Travel to Prague in under 6 hours. Private transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day is at leisure. Overnight in Prague. (B)

Day 11: Today, Grand City Tour of Prague. You'll visit all the major sights. Drive across the Vltava to the Old Town Square Rest of the day at leisure. Overnight in Prague. (B)

Day 12: After breakfast, board a boat on the Vltava river and take 2.5 hour cruise. Lunch is provided. Afternoon is free. Overnight in Prague. (B,L)

Day 13: After breakfast, full day tour to Cesky Krumlov. Return to Prague. (B)

Day 14: Private transfer to the airport. This is the end of your tour. (B)
