Day by Day Itinerary

Day 1. Vienna
 Arrive in Vienna, the capital of Austria. Private transfer to your hotel. Rest of the day at leisure. In deluxe category, the historic Grand Wien is featured. It is located downtown, within walking distance of Vienna's major sights. Mercure Wien Westbahnhof - in first class - and Furst Metternich in standard class, are close to public transportation. Overnight in Vienna.

Day 2. Vienna
 Buffet breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, guided Grand Sightseeing Tour of Vienna, including the Ringstrasse, the Vienna State Opera House, the Hofburg Palace, the Museums of Fine Arts and Natural History, the Parliament, the City Hall and the University. You will also visit the Belvedere Palace and the magnificent Imperial Rooms of the Schönbrunn Palace. Overnight in Vienna (B)

Day 3. Vienna
 Today is at leisure. Have a late breakfast at the hotel. You might go for a walk afterwards, maybe taste the famous Sacher torte in a cozy Cafe. Perhaps, you would like to visit the countryside, the romantic Danube Valley with Melk, Dürnstein and the Wachau. For tonight, we suggest that you plan a fun dinner in Grinzing, the famous wine growing village in the outskirts of Vienna. In Grinzing's "Heurigen" restaurants dinner is always accompanied by "Schrammel" music, played usually by a quartet; violins, an accordion & a guitar. (optional) Overnight in Vienna. (B)

Day 4. Prague
 Buffet breakfast at your hotel. After breakfast, check out and make your way to the Train Station. Travel to Prague, the capital of the Czech Republic. Upon arrival, private transfer to your hotel. In deluxe category, Hotel Paris in Old Town is featured. Hotel Unic in first class is also at Old Town. Hotel Prague Centre Plaza is offered in standard category. Overnight in Prague, your choice of hotel. (B)

Day 5. Prague
 Buffet breakfast at your hotel. Your morning historical city tour includes the St. Vitus Cathedral, the Hradcany Castle, the Loreto Church, the Old Town Square, the Tyn Church, the Charles Bridge, the Wenceslas Square and the old Jewish Quarter. Overnight in Prague. (B)

Day 6. Prague
 Full day at leisure. After buffet breakfast at your hotel, you might want to visit a couple of the famous Bohemian Castles. The Karlstejn Castle, built in the 14th century, and the former hunting lodge Konopiste, with a fascinating collection of historical weapons, furnishings, late Gothic paintings, tapestries & hunting trophies. (Optional) Return to Prague in the late afternoon hours. Overnight in Prague. (B)

Day 7. Prague - Departure
 Buffet breakfast at the hotel. End of your independent rail tour. (B)
